RESPECT YOUR BANKNOTES: RBI APPEALS TO PUBLIC

THE RESERVE BANK OF INDIA TODAY APPEALED TO MEMBERS OF PUBLIC NOT TO USE BANK NOTES FOR MAKING GARLANDS, DECORATING PANDALS AND PLACES OF WORSHIP OR FOR SHOWERING ON PERSONALITIES IN SOCIAL EVENTS ETC., SUCH ACTIONS DEFACE THE BANKNOTES AND SHORTEN THEIR LIFE, THE RESERVE BANK STATED AND ADDED THAT BANKNOTES SHOULD BE RESPECTED AS THEY ARE A SYMBOL OF THE SOVEREIGN AND PUBLIC SHOULD NOT MISUSE THEM AND HELP IN INCREASING THE LIFE OF BANKNOTES. THE RESERVE BANK HAS ALSO STATED THAT IT HAS BEEN TAKING ALL MEASURES TO SUPPLY CLEAN BANKNOTES ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND HAS URGED THE MEMBERS OF PUBLIC TO CONTRIBUTE THEIR MITE TO ITS EFFORTS IN PURSUING A 'CLEAN NOTE POLICY' FOR THE COUNTRY.
